



# Curriculum Overview

## Curriculum Area: Health and Social Care

Year: 11

### Curriculum covered

#### Autumn Term

#### **Unit RO22 – Communicating and working with individuals in health, social care and early years settings.**

The topics covered are, how to communicate effectively, and the personal qualities that contribute to effective care as well as showing they can communicate effectively within a health, social care and early years setting.

#### **Autumn and Spring term**

**Unit RO23: Understanding body systems and disorders.** Topics covered include, how the body systems work, the disorders/illnesses that affect body systems and to be able to interpret data obtained from measuring body rates with reference to the functioning of health body systems.

#### **Autumn, Spring and Summer Term**

**Unit RO21 – Essential Values of Care for use with individuals in care settings.** Topics covered include how to support individuals in maintaining their rights, the values of care and how they should be applied, how legislation impacts on care settings and how personal hygiene, safety and security measure protect individuals.

### Internal Assessment

#### Assessment opportunities - formative and summative

**RO21-** mock exam from past paper, March 2020

**RO22-** written assignment and practical completed in Term 1 of Year 11.

**RO23-** written assignment and practical completed in Term 2 of Year 11.

Mini deadlines throughout each unit ensure regular summative assessment and enables pupils to break the large units down into manageable tasks.

Past exam papers will be used to monitor progress and retention of the subject knowledge and exam technique as formative assessment.
