Curriculum Area: Geography Year: 11

Curriculum covered

Autumn and Spring Term – Challenge of Resource Management: Demand for water resources is rising globally but supply can be insecure, which may lead to conflict. Different strategies can be used to increase water supply.

Urban Issues and Challenges: A growing percentage of the world's population lives in urban areas. Urban growth creates opportunities and challenges for cities in LICs and NEEs. Urban change in cities in the UK leads to a variety of social, economic, and environmental opportunities and challenges. Urban sustainability requires management of resources and transport.

Changing Economic World: There are global variations in economic development and quality of life.

Spring Term - Changing Economic World – Continued: Various strategies exist for reducing the global development gap. Some LICs or NEEs are experiencing rapid economic development which leads to significant social, environmental and cultural change. Major changes in the economy of the UK have affected and will continue to affect employment patterns and regional growth.

Challenge of Resource Management: The global distribution of food, water and energy resources is uneven. The changing demand and provision of resources in the UK create opportunities and challenges.
