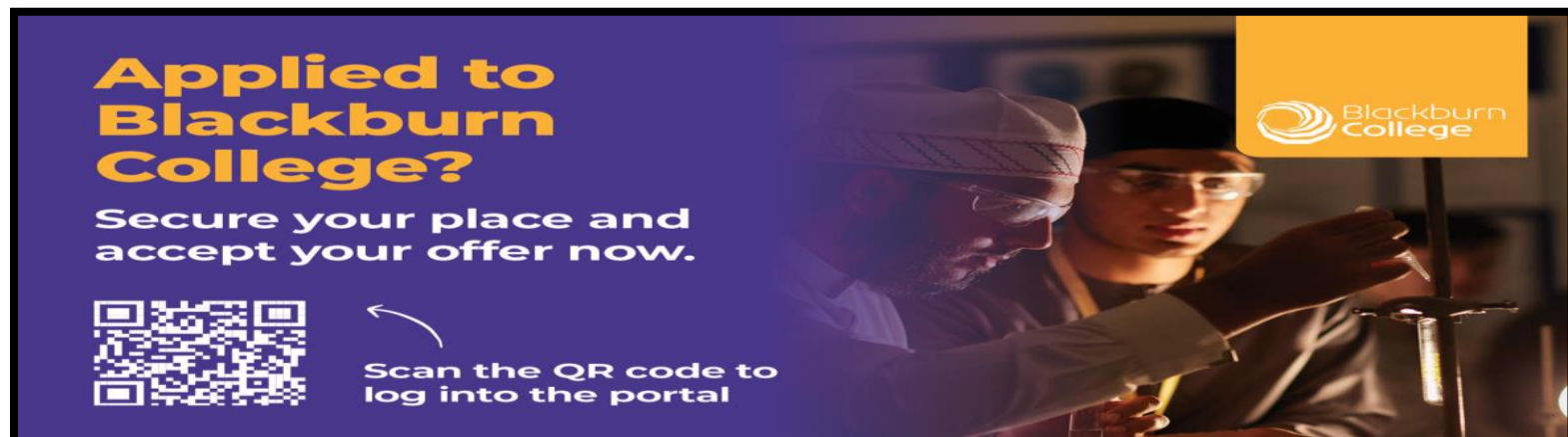
1. Make sure you are using the email address you applied to Preston College with.

# JOB OF THE WEEK

## NEUROLOGIST



Annual salaries £24,907 to £62,001 per year.

 **WORKING HOURS**  
**37 to 39 a week**

You could work: evenings; flexibly

**Working Environment** – You could work in an NHS or private hospital or in the community.

Neurologists diagnose, treat and manage disorders that affect the central nervous system (the brain and spinal cord) and the peripheral nervous system (nerves and muscles which activate movement and transmit sensation from all parts of the body to the brain).



Neurologists treat conditions such as:

- Stroke
- Multiple sclerosis
- Headaches
- Blackouts
- Peripheral neuropathy (disease affecting the nerves) including chronic neuropathic pain
- Parkinson's disease and other movement disorders (e.g. tremor)
- Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia
- Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis also known as motor neuron disease, causing weakness and muscle wasting due to nerve degeneration)
- Epilepsy
- Spinal cord diseases
- Muscle diseases like muscular dystrophy (causing weakness of muscle fibres)
- Myasthenia gravis (where the muscles become weak and tire easily) and related disorders
- Brain tumours
- Functional disorders (symptoms which cannot be explained by neurological damage)

Skills required to be a neurologist. While performing their daily responsibilities, neurologists make use of several skills including:

Problem-solving - Dexterity - Communication - Leadership

Neurologists often work with a medical team that helps them fulfil their duties. When their team helps them with tests and treatments, neurologists must show strong leadership capabilities to communicate tasks and sometimes physically demonstrate how to perform procedures.

As a consultant you will gradually gain more experience in your clinical duties and take on more responsibilities. You'll have the opportunity to move into managerial roles, initially as a medical lead, then as a clinical director and later on as a medical director.

What is involved in becoming a neurologist? The qualifications necessary to become a neurologist include:

- Undergraduate degree
- Doctoral degree
- Completion of medical residency program
- Certification and state license

Though there are several undergraduate degrees you can earn to help you pursue a career as a neurologist, some of the most influential degrees include biology, physics and chemistry.

To become a neurologist, you'll need to start by taking a degree in medicine recognised by the General Medical Council (GMC). This usually takes five to six years to complete.

### Volunteering and work experience

Before applying to do a medical degree, you'll be expected to undertake work experience, either paid or voluntary, in areas relevant to medicine. This could be through work experience at your local hospital, nursing home or through work shadowing a doctor. This experience shows your commitment to becoming a doctor and provides insight into the physical and emotional demands of working in medicine
